顺服的功课
第2课
听神的话 (约拿)

写给父母：

这张反馈单让您知悉您的孩子今天在主日学所学的内容。包含“牢记神的话语”，一个建议的活动来巩固课程内容，还有一个简短的祷告。参与以上内容并和孩子交流，对您和孩子都会非常有益。

所学内容：



今天，我们继续学习服从，明白了为什么接受神的话并按祂所说的去做很重要，而不是找借口逃避。我们看到，当约拿没有顺服神的命令时，发生了什么。当我们不顺服神时，也会有负面的后果。我们可能会感到难过，有人可能会受到伤害，甚至会错过神一直以来为我们准备的真正美好的事物（使用的经文：约拿书1:1-17）

牢记神的话语：



“耶稣说，那听神的话而遵行的人，更是有福的。” 路加福音11:28

一周里跟孩子要多练习这节经文。这不仅会帮助孩子记住这节经文，也会帮助他/她巩固课堂里所学的内容。

建议的亲子活动(只适合懂英文的大人/孩子)：



本周找一天，玩“疯狂借口”。首先，找一个任务或一项活动，然后大声说出来，例如“打扫房间”。另一个人要提出一个借口，要用字母A打头的单词作动词和名词。然后，第一个人再提出一个借口，为什么他们不能做这件事，要用字母B打头的单词作动词和名词。一直继续到字母Z。

示例：第1个人“打扫房间”

第2个人：“除非你Admire an Alligator，不然我不能打扫房间”

第1个人：“除非你Burn the Bacon，不然我不能Admire an Alligator”

第2个人：“除非你Catch a Centipede，不然我不能Burn the Bacon”

一个规则：借口必须合理：例如，你可以cook a cabbage，但不能cook a can opener。看看谁能提出最疯狂的借口，一起笑笑。游戏结束时，说明为什么任何不遵守神圣言的借口都是疯狂的借口。

每天的祷告：



亲爱的神，请帮我顺从你的话，而不是提愚蠢的借口来逃避你让我做的事。主啊，求你给我加力，当有人需要帮助，拥抱或祷告时，我不会逃避。虽然我还只是个孩子，但我要让其他人看到，耶稣在我里面活着。阿们！

SUNDAY SCHOOL TAKE HOME PAGE

To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned today in Sunday School. Included are "Words to Remember" from the Bible, a suggested activity to reinforce the lesson, and a short prayer. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What We Learned:



Today we continued learning about obedience and discovered why it is important to take God at His Word. We should do what He says, instead of coming up with excuses. We saw what happened to Jonah when he did not do what God asked of him. There will also be negative consequences when we disobey God. We may feel sad later, someone else may feel hurt, or we may miss out on something nice the Lord wanted to give to us all along. (Scripture used: Jonah 1:1-17)

Words to Remember:



"Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it." Luke 11:28 NIV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help your child to remember the verse, but also it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



One day this week play CrAZy Excuses. To start, come up with a task or activity and say it out loud, like "Clean your room." The other person comes up with an excuse, using the letter A for a verb and noun. Then the first person comes up with another excuse why they can't do the previous task using the letter B. Continue to the letter Z. Example: Person 1 "Clean your room" Person 2 "I can't clean my room until you Admire an Alligator" Person 1 "I can't admire an alligator until you Burn the Bacon" Person 2 "I can't burn the bacon until you Catch a Centipede" One rule: Excuses must be plausible: For example, you can cook a cabbage, but you can't cook a can opener. See who can come up with the craziest excuses, and have a good laugh. At the end of the game, explain how giving any excuse for not obeying God's Word is always a crazy excuse.

Daily Prayer:



Dear Lord, help me be obedient to Your Word, and not come up with silly excuses to avoid doing what You want me to do. Give me encouragement Lord so I will not shy away when someone needs a helping hand, a hug, or a prayer. Although I am only a child, let others see Jesus alive in me. Amen.
